During the month of October PUF children (code 42/44/47) will receive their IPP with goals for the year. Parents will have a collaborative meeting with the BCESA team to review the IPP. Regular therapy visits will also begin this month. PUF children will see the therapists weekly for sessions. Contact notes will be sent home after each session so you can practice at home.

### MOD-Language

During the month of October Moderate-Language (code 48) children will receive an IPP with goals for the year. Parents will have a collaborative meeting with the BCESA team to review the IPP. Regular therapy visits will also begin this month.

MOD children will see the Speech-Language Pathologist every other week and contact notes will be sent home after each session so you can practice at home.

This month, Mild to Moderate children (code 30) will continue to be observed by therapists and IPPs will be written and sent to parents in November.

Regular monthly therapist visits will also begin in November.
